Dr. Neugarten received his dental degree from the Columbia University School of Dental and Oral Surgery, where he was named class valedictorian and earned membership in the national dental honor society, Omicron Kappa Upsilon. He completed his oral and maxillofacial training at the Northwell Health System, Long Island Jewish Hospital, and earned a medical degree from the Stony Brook School of Medicine.

He maintains a private practice in New York City and Long Island, New York.
